Greetings ministry partners in the mighty name of Jesus:

We are happy to report that we have arrived home about a week ago and to the best of our ability completed the assignment that God gave us over these past 3 months. We are enjoying meeting with friends and family and getting caught up on what has been happening in their lives.

This was our 5th ministry trip to Africa and continues to be the most difficult place we have served.

Our spiritual theme was, "Our God will make a way where there seems no other way." This proved true over and over again as we laboured to advance the Kingdom of God.

Some individuals were introduced to Jesus for the first time. Some were healed from various infirmities and others set free from demonic strongholds. For all of this we give thanks to Jesus who gave us spiritual strength and wisdom. Local believers were disciplined daily in the life principles of being a Christian.

The second school foundation has been completed and we will begin construction on the walls in 2011.

Sudan Christian Outreach Ministry (SCOM) was blessed with a gift of \$10,000 for 2 water wells. One well was drilled at our main mission base in Kanyara and the other well was drilled at the health clinic in Wudabe near the Congo border. We are happy to announce that we no longer need to collect rain water which was a big problem during the dry season. We have given permission to all of our neighbours to come and help themselves to clean, save drinking water. This will save our neighbour women hours of laborious work walking to the next nearest well for their daily water needs. Some were collecting water from the ditch. These new wells are a huge blessing.

Our current Sudan project is to raise the \$10,000 needed to construct a suite at the Wudabe clinic which we hope to build in 2011.

We are now organizing and planning for the next Cuba delivery trip which will be the end of November.
